ESP Research and Teaching:** technical writing, corpus resources, English for vocational education/business/management/tourism/science/technology/engineering, innovations in ESP curriculum design, international/inter-cultural communication, trends and challenges in English for specific purposes, and other relevant topics;
- **5. Translation Studies:** theory and practice of translation and interpretation, translation and interpretation teaching, audiovisual translation, game localization, translation and technology, news translation, and other relevant topics.
- 6. Other Topics such as Literature and Language Teaching

TYPES OF PRESENTATIONS

- **1. Oral presentation:** Each paper will be allocated 20 minutes for oral presentation and 5 minutes for discussion.
- **2. Poster presentation:** A dedicated area and time slot will be arranged for display and discussion of posters.
